Of the 425 members - 329 have Wellington as their Home Club.

As always there were two groups who did lessons with Alan Grant this year. A large group of 36 people started in February with 24 starting playing on Tuesdays after the lessons and three weeks of playing with more experienced buddies. Around 12 are still playing regularly. We are planning to contact the others before the end of the year in order to support them back into playing in the new-year. The group of 27 who started in June will play with buddies in November before 'graduating' to Tuesday nights. A one session Novice event is planned for early November to encourage these newer players to Tournament Bridge.

Given the significant cost involved it was decided to spread the costs over two financial years but at the same time complete the painting as quickly as possible to ensure our key asset is maintained. There are other major projects which we would like to achieve to make sure the building is maintained and enhanced for the use of members. The major works involve the kitchen area, some work in the Foyer area, and heating, lighting and ceiling tiles in the Pipitea Room. There will be discussion at the AGM on ways to fund these necessary future upgrades.

## **Treasurer's Report 2015**

The 2014-2015 year has generally been a good one for the club. Overall we are in a very sound financial position.

The three main areas this report will cover are the buildings maintenance, the bar, and insurance.

We made a small loss this year of \$1,968. We had budgeted for a surplus of \$4,362.

The main reason for the deficit was that we undertook the painting of the exterior of the building. We had initially budgeted for \$10,000 of programmed maintenance, but later made the decision to proceed with the painting of the whole building this year. \$33,600 was spent in the 2014-2015 year, and a further \$17,800 this financial year to finish.

We therefore spent \$23,600 more on maintenance than budgeted for, but the overall budget was only \$6,200 less than expected. This was due to a combination of receiving more income than expected, and spending less in other areas.

Following on from last year's audit report, there were a lot of changes made with controls around the bar.

A cash box was purchased so that loose notes were not left lying about on the trolley. A daily total of cash sales was kept, and reconciled to the estimated sales based on items sold, and also monthly stocktakes and trading accounts were completed.

This was quite a lot of extra work, but obviously worth it as can be seen from the bar trading account for the year. Annual takings were down by \$4,667 from 2014 (due to the change in legislation and people drinking less), but profit was up by just over \$1,000. The gross profit percentage increased from 34.7% to 42.5%.

The controls put in place will continue to make sure that our profitability in this area is maintained.

We had an updated valuation of the buildings carried out in November 2014. The cost to reinstate the building in the event of a loss was estimated at \$1,980,000. We have the building insured for \$2,230,000 which allows for inflationary provisions, demolition and reinstatement. Contents are insured for \$400,000.

The rating value from the Wellington City Council is \$2,450,000.

Thanks very much to Bridget for all the help she has given me throughout the year, and also to Nikki Shone for her excellent work as honorary auditor.

## Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year to 31 July 2015

### 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Club is an Incorporated Society registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The Financial Statements have been prepared according to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

The Club is entitled to use differential reporting exemptions because it is not publicly accountable and it is not large. The Club has applied all differential reporting exemptions.

The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Club is a going concern. All income and expenditure is brought to account on an accrual basis.

#### PARTICULAR ACCOUNTING POLICIES

**Stock on Hand** – Alcohol stocks are valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value

**Fixed Assets** – Assets are stated at cost and depreciated over their estimated economic life using the following rates:

Buildings	100 years (1%) straight line
Furniture and Fittings	10 years (10%) diminishing value
Computer, Printer and Other Office Equipment	3 years (33%) diminishing value

**GST** – The Club is a “GST Registered Person” and these accounts are prepared on a GST exclusive basis, so that GST is not included in any account other than as a receivable or payable in the Statement of Financial Position.


There has been no change to accounting policy.
