President's Report

1 Introduction

On behalf of the committee and the club I have pleasure in presenting the Annual Report for the Wellington Bridge Club for the 2012/13 year. The role of President has been made much easier by the work of a very dedicated committee and a very hard working and professional club manager. Club membership continues to grow as does total player session attendances.

The development of a new web site at the beginning of the year has improved the ease of providing club members with results and other club information.

It is pleasing to report a small financial surplus for the year after our initial budget had forecast a loss. However, capital expenditure on heat pumps, and more recently ceiling and lights in the main playing room has resulted in a reduction of cash reserves over the last year. In the coming year there will be a significant cost associated with necessary exterior building maintenance.

Club members continue to do well in local and national competitions. It is great that the club has had six members representing New Zealand in overseas competitions; well done to those players. The club is again in the National Club Championship after winning the Regional competition earlier this year.

3 Lessons and Membership

Once again we have had a good number of new players come along to the beginners lessons this year. Alan Grant with the assistance of some club members has again run the beginners lessons in the first and second half of the year. We are looking at ways of keeping the interest of these newer players and ensuring they get some ongoing lessons to improve their bridge along the way.

We continued with social bridge this year with mixed success. There was some interest but the ongoing time commitment and the numbers attending has meant we are currently assessing if/or how social bridge may continue.

4 Property and Building

The new heat pumps were installed in the main playing room towards the end of last year. These are working well and make controlling the room temperature much easier. As well the power costs have significantly reduced.

Following the recent earthquakes we had the building visually inspected by an engineer and he found no evidence of any structural damage. Three ceiling tiles fell in the main playing room mainly as a consequence of some previous level of wear and tear around the perimeter fixings. Given the type of ceiling tiles it was decided to replace, rather than repair, the ceiling. At the same time we took the opportunity to replace the lighting. This has much improved the ambience in the main playing room. The committee will be investigating both the heating and ceiling in the Motorway playing room however, club finances may mean it is some time before any improvements can be made in that room.

11 Financial Overview

It is my pleasure to present the 2013 annual accounts for the Wellington Bridge Club to the AGM.

Last year a loss of \$26,179 was reported at the AGM. After that result, we looked at ways to improve the club's income. Rentals on car-parks and hire of rooms were increased, subscriptions and table money were increased, and we concentrated on efforts to improving the performance of the bar.

The combined effect of these changes, along with a \$5,000 reduction in power costs, has resulted in the reporting of a surplus in this financial year.

The bar was an excellent turnaround. We also have had a small increase in membership and expenses were down by around \$10,500 for the year.

We have made some changes in the reporting of income and expenses this year. Subscriptions in advance (our membership year is from 1 January to 31 December) and prepaid insurance (which runs from 1 June to 31 May) are now both recorded in the accounts. The combined effect of making these changes has been to increase net income by around \$3,300.

In July this year we paid \$5,000 to remove the ceiling tiles following damage in the June earthquake and this amount was included in the 2013 accounts.

Assets purchased during the year were 4 Heat pumps for the main playing room (\$16,762), a defibrillator (\$2,800), dishwasher (\$4,340), and a new laptop (\$1,685).

The current year's budget shows a breakeven position. This includes a maintenance budget of \$25,000, in anticipation of work required to the outside of the building. The budget also anticipates a small increase in membership fees.

Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year to 31 July 2013

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Club is an Incorporated Society registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The Financial Statements have been prepared according to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

The Club is entitled to use differential reporting exemptions because it is not publicly accountable and it is not large. The Club has applied all differential reporting exemptions.

The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Club is a going concern. All income and expenditure is brought to account on an accrual basis.

PARTICULAR ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Stock on Hand – Alcohol stocks are valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value

Fixed Assets – Assets are stated at cost and depreciated over their estimated economic life using the following rates:

Buildings	100 years (1%) straight line
Furniture and Fittings	10 years (10%) diminishing value
Computer, Printer and Other Office Equipment	3 years (33%) diminishing value

GST – The Club is a “GST Registered Person” and these accounts are prepared on a GST exclusive basis, so that GST is not included in any account other than as a receivable or payable in the Statement of Financial Position.

CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

We have changed the way we account for subscriptions, insurance, and honorariums to more accurately match income and expenses by accounting for accruals.

The year for subscriptions is the calendar year to 31 December. Therefore as at 31 July we have 5 months (\$12,568) subscriptions in advance.

Insurance runs from 1 June to 31 May. Therefore there is 10 months of prepaid insurance from 1 August to 31 May (\$18,875.80).

Honorariums are payable after the AGM for the calendar year being reported on. As at 31/07/2013 honoraria were due for the Treasurer, Chief Director, and the auditor of \$1,000 each.

The effect of introducing these changes this year has increased the net surplus by \$3,307.80.
