1 Introduction

6 Directing and Dealing

The club has sixteen active Directors, of which four are Tournament Directors and one National Director. We appreciate and thank them for their efforts over the year, and especially for continuing in that role despite the occasional mishap. The game could not be played without cards, and during the year there were 524 sets of boards dealt for club nights along with a further 118 sets for Interclub and tournaments. Most of the dealing has been done by Mat Carlsson, our current resident dealer but during the year we farewelled Duncan Reid (who had dealt for the club for about eight years) and Matt Newell. We are most appreciative for the efforts of all three.

We are pleased to note that the number of fouled boards during the year has reduced to almost nil. In part, this is due to the new dealing machine that arrived towards the end of last year and the fact that the dealers have been given their own space in one of our upstairs rooms to undertake the dealing.

10 Financial Overview – Treasurer’s Report 2014

There are a number of accounts where the comparisons to the previous year are out of sync because of changes to the accounting policy over the last couple of years. This has affected Subscriptions, Bridge Levies, Honoraria, Club Manager’s Salary, and Insurance.

Subscriptions – the policy for accounting for subscriptions was changed as the subscription year runs from 1 January to 31 December. If we had not changed the policy the subscriptions last year would have been \$30,148.

Honoraria – We pay \$1,000 each to the Treasurer, Auditor and the Club Director. Last year we accrued payments due at the end of the year. We have not changed any of the amounts paid.

Insurance – this is for the period from 1 June to 31 May. If we had not changed the policy the insurance cost in 2013 would have been \$20,755.

Club Manager – Bridget had built up several weeks of annual leave as at the end of the last financial year. This has been accrued as a liability of \$4,950, which has added to the cost of the Club Manager. Without this, the cost would have been \$39,502 in 2014.

NZ Bridge Levies – Previously these were included with subscriptions income, and then shown as an expense when paid to NZ Bridge. When levies are received they are now accrued as a liability in the balance sheet. As at 31 July 2014, we owed NZ Bridge \$3,150.

Rentals on carparks and rooms were increased in 2013. The income from car parking increased by just over \$5,000 compared to the same period in 2013.

Table money was increased by \$1 in early 2013. The full effect of this is seen in the increased table money of around \$7,000.

Bridge playing costs increased by around \$4,000. This is for the cost of suppers, playing cards, stationery, prizes and Masterpoints. Part of this increase was due to a large stock of scoring pads etc being printed in 2014. Also there were some

computing costs charged in 2014 which will be separately accounted for in 2015.

Building costs include all repairs, rates, fire safety charges etc. Last year we had problems after the earthquake with the ceiling tiles in the main playing room. Included in the building costs is the repair cost of \$10,248. We were intending to start the maintenance of the outside of the building last financial year, and this is the reason the budget for building costs was \$34,450.

Assets - Last year we purchased a new dealing machine costing \$6,621, which is included as a fixed asset. A quiz evening was held to fundraise for this, where we raised close to \$3,500. Also charged to fixed assets was the cost of new light fittings in the main playing room, which cost \$11,833.

Bar Receipts - Our auditor has expressed her concern in the operation of our bar by qualifying the accounts. She has also been quite clear that she will not continue in this role unless we put in controls to prevent this continuing. While we have made some improvements to the operation of the bar, there is obviously a lot more we need to do.

Since the audit report, we have put in place different procedures for monitoring the takings, and will be conducting regular stocktakes, and trading accounts to determine profitability. Security of the stock has also been improved. We will keep the membership informed via the newsletter of progress.

Subscriptions and Fees 2015 - The committee has recommended that there be no change to the subscriptions this year. There is no intention to increase table money any further in the short term. We are hopeful that we will earn more income this year on the bar by improving the controls mentioned above.

Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year to 31 July 2014

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Club is an Incorporated Society registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The Financial Statements have been prepared according to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

The Club is entitled to use differential reporting exemptions because it is not publicly accountable and it is not large. The Club has applied all differential reporting exemptions.

The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost. Reliance is placed on the fact that the Club is a going concern. All income and expenditure is brought to account on an accrual basis.

PARTICULAR ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Stock on Hand – Alcohol stocks are valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value

Fixed Assets – Assets are stated at cost and depreciated over their estimated economic life using the following rates:

Buildings	100 years (1%) straight line
Furniture and Fittings	10 years (10%) diminishing value
Computer, Printer and Other Office Equipment	3 years (33%) diminishing value

GST – The Club is a “GST Registered Person” and these accounts are prepared on a GST exclusive basis, so that GST is not included in any account other than as a receivable or payable in the Statement of Financial Position.

CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Holiday pay has been included as a cost in 2014 (\$4,950). Bridge levies when received are now treated as a liability.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT


I have audited the Balance Sheet of the Wellington Bridge Club as at 31 July 2014 and the related statements of profit and loss for the year then ended. The financial statements are the responsibility of the Bridge Club. My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit.

I have conducted the audit with the objectives of, understanding and evaluate the controls in place for the Club, evaluating and testing those controls, and recommending additional controls where applicable.

The club's internal controls over financial reporting include the policies and procedures that provide, amongst other things, reasonable assurance regarding prevention or timely detection of unauthorised removal of the club's stock, cash or assets, which could have a material effect on the financial statements.

I believe that there is some form of unauthorised removal of either bar stock or bar receipts as the profit for the bar as reported in the accounts does not reflect the expected profit given the stock purchases, selling price and stock on hand reconciliation that I have performed. The difference is material to the accounts and amounted to \$8000 understated on the bar sales.

In my opinion the financial statements referred to above present fairly, other than as qualified above, the financial position of the Wellington Bridge Club as at 31 July 2014.
